

This side letter of agreement shall replace the entirety of Section 25.3 of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Montecito Firefighter’s Association and the Montecito Fire Protection District dated June 29, 2016.

Section 25.3

The District shall pay the entire premium for employee and eligible dependents for the Delta Dental PPO Plus Premier Plan, effective January 1, 2019.

23. PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS

In addition to introductory evaluations, performance evaluations for each employee shall be completed annually, during or after the month of November. These evaluations will be reviewed between the employee and immediate supervisor, with a copy submitted to the employee and the original submitted as a permanent record in the individual's personnel file.

An employee may have total review of the evaluation with his/her immediate supervisor and the Fire Chief.

24. MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

District and Association agree that the District shall continue to provide a program of periodic medical exams. The District retains full and complete control over this program and will advise the Association of program changes. An employee absent on leave for a continuous period of 122 days shall be required to have a physical examination, including a stress EKG test, by a District doctor prior to returning to duty.

25. HEALTH INSURANCE

25.1 The District will contribute to the employee's health care premium, for the employee and eligible dependents, using the following schedule:

August 1, 2016 - \$1,800
 January 1, 2017 - \$1,950
 January 1, 2018 - \$2,125
 January 1, 2019 - \$2,315

25.2 Health (up to the maximum stated in 25.1), dental and vision insurance premiums shall continue to be paid for by the District for all retirees and eligible dependents per Board Resolution electing to be subject to Meyers-Geddes State Employees Medical and Hospital Care Act adopted 9/15/69.

25.3 The District shall pay the entire premium for employee and eligible dependents for the Delta Dental Premier plan. The parties agree to continue searching for a comparable dental plan and pursue the District's needs regarding reduction in dental plan costs.

25.4 The District will pay the entire premium for employee and eligible dependents for vision insurance administered by Vision Service Plan.

1 Balance Sheet	0115	Fair market value adjustments posted by the County on a quarterly basis.
2 Balance Sheet	0211	Property tax revenue impounded by the Auditor-Controller's Office due to large assessment appeals that have not been settled.
3 Balance Sheet	0230	The Account Receivable balance includes four fire assignment reimbursements from last fiscal year. Payment is expected by December.
4 Balance Sheet	1015 & 1210	The EFT and accounts payable account reflects expenses entered by month-end, but disbursement payment wasn't completed until the next month.
5 Balance Sheet	2130	Fund Balance - Committed maintains the District's reserve balances as of 7/1/18: Catastrophic \$2,400,000 and Economic Uncertainties \$3,670,000.
6 Balance Sheet	2200	Fund Balance - Residual has a negative balance due to cash flow shortages. Reserves are used to cover the shortages until property tax revenues are received in December.
7 Balance Sheet	Fund 3652 0550	The deposit is for a prepaid engine with an expected delivery of December 2018.
8 Financial Status	Revenues: Taxes	Approximately 55% of the District's property tax revenues are expected by the end of December.
9 Financial Status	6301	The overtime reimbursable account exceeds the budgeted amount due to another busy fire season. An amendment will be presented in June to adjust the budgeted amount.
10 Financial Status	7030	This account has reached 77% of its budget because a new set of turnouts, totaling \$40,000, was purchased in September.
11 Financial Status	7205	Hazard mitigation projects have started back up in November.
12 Revenue Transactions	3750 & 4476	The District has received reimbursements from CalOES and FEMA for the Public Assistance Disaster Relief Program for two projects: RAWs unit replacement and the rental housing insurance deductible.
13 Financial Trend	7120	The expenses in this account are higher than it past years because the District is incurring generator rental expenses of \$2,300/month.
14 Financial Trend	7650	The District incurred a \$24,000 expense for the Prop 4 Mail Ballot election, which happens every 4 years.
15 Financial Trend	7901	The transfers shown in previous years were for the Pension Obligation Fund payments. The final payment was posted in May of 2018.
16 Expenditure Trend	6600	The expense in August includes insurance benefits for September, totaling \$134,000.

Topic: Establishing Appropriations Limit for FY 2017-18

Summary

In July 2017, Staff started working with former Auditor-Controller, Bob Geis, to recalculate the District's Appropriations Limit by taking into consideration all factors that are allowable by law. On January 22, 2018, the Board of Directors approved Resolution 2018-09, which retroactively updated the appropriations limits from fiscal year 1991-92 through 2016-17. This report summarizes the factors used to calculate the appropriations limit for fiscal year 2017-18.

Discussion

California voters, in November of 1979 passed Proposition 4, which added Article XIIB to the State Constitution. This article establishes limits on the appropriation of proceeds of taxes. In June of 1990, the voters passed Proposition 111, which updates the State's and local agencies' appropriations limit calculation to allow for new funding, while still providing an overall limit on state and local funding.

Prior to the passage of Proposition 111, the limit was based on the 1978-79 proceeds of taxes adjusted annually for population and cost of living changes. Proposition 111 established new cost of living factors and new population factors for use by local governments.

Cost of Living: Local governments may annually choose, by a recorded vote of the governing body, either:

- The change in California per capita personal income (3.69% for FY 2017-18), or
- The percentage change in the jurisdiction's assessed valuation attributable to non-residential new construction (6.92% for FY 2017-18).

Population: Since Montecito Fire's jurisdiction is located in the unincorporated area of the County, use either:

- The change for the County (0.76% in FY 2017-18), or
- The change for the unincorporated area of the County (0.82% in FY 2017-18).

Conclusion

Staff is submitting to the Board of Directors a report and resolution for FY 2017-18 for the Montecito Fire Protection District that selects:

- This results in an increase in the appropriation limit by a factor of 1.07797 to \$11,918,248.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Montecito Fire Protection District that the Board elects for FY 2017-18 to use the change in non-residential new construction of 1.0692 and the change in the county unincorporated area population of 1.0082. The factors increase the appropriation limit by a factor of 1.07797 and sets the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2017-18 at \$11,918,248 before application of a voter approved appropriations limit override.

- RESOLVED, (b) Montecito Fire Protection District has fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507 in electing the benefits set forth above; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (c) That the participation of the employees and annuitants of Montecito Fire Protection District shall be subject to determination of its status as an "agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State" that is eligible to participate in a governmental plan within the meaning of Section 414(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, upon publication of final Regulations pursuant to such Section. If it is determined that Montecito Fire Protection District would not qualify as an agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State under such final Regulations, CalPERS may be obligated, and reserves the right to terminate the health coverage of all participants of the employer.
- RESOLVED, (d) That the executive body appoint and direct, and it does hereby appoint and direct, Fire Chief to file with the Board a verified copy of this resolution, and to perform on behalf of Montecito Fire Protection District all functions required of it under the Act.

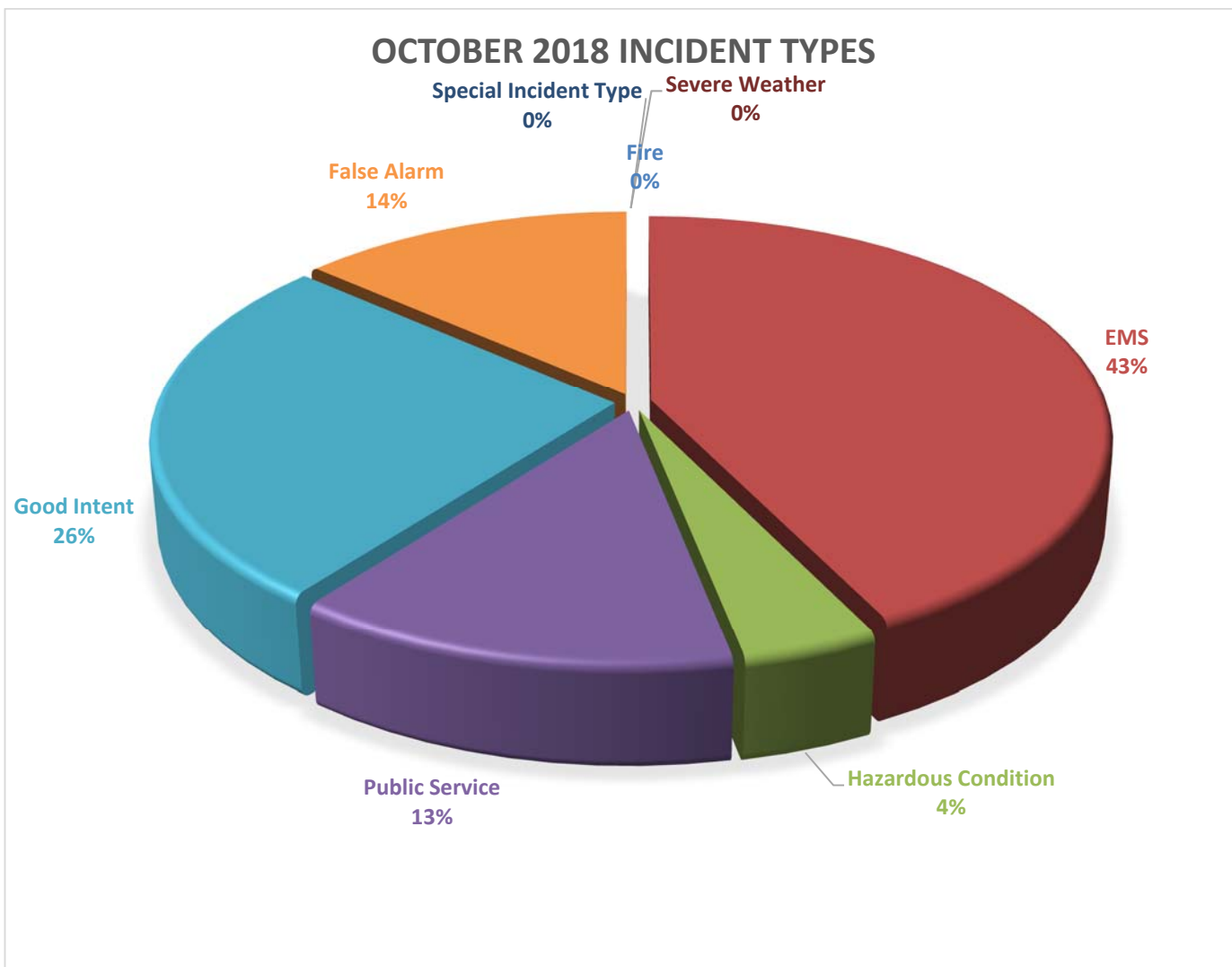
